Community Advisory: Bicycle Thefts

Over the past few days there have been reports of bicycles stolen from residential areas on campus (Middle Earth, Verano Place and Vista del Campo Norte).

Safety Tips:

Always lock your bicycle to a secure bike rack. Secure both wheels and frame.

Use a high quality "U" shaped lock. AVOID using lightweight cables or chains, or low quality U-locks.

Avoid leaving your bicycle outside overnight.
