Department**CRIME ALERT****Burglary**

UCI Police Department is investigating two burglaries that occurred in Vista del Campo and Camino del Sol student housing. The first burglary occurred on November 14, 2020. The suspect gained entrance into the apartment and encountered residents. The suspect fled. UCIPD sent a zotALERT at 3:35 a.m. notifying the UCI community and provided a brief description of the suspect; a male wearing a gray or black hoodie.

At 9:17 a.m. on November 14, 2020, UCIPD received a report that a burglary took place at Camino del Sol student housing. An unknown subject entered the housing office. It is unknown at this time if items were taken from the office.

If you have information that could be helpful in this investigation, please contact the UCI Police Department at (949) 824-5223. While UCIPD has increased patrols in the area, it is important for residents to follow the safety tips outlined below.

Help fight crime by reporting suspicious activity to UCIPD immediately - race, gender, and religious affiliation are not considered suspicious.

- Ensure that all doors and windows are locked. Do not prop doors open.
- Never leave electronics, wallets, and other valuables in plain sight.
