Sexual Assault

UCI Police Department received a report of a sexual assault that occurred in an off campus apartment, near UCI. This took place between September 29, 2019 and October 2, 2019 between the hours of 3p.m. and 9 p.m. The victim rented a room from the suspect through an online rental agency.
